Mixing Bleach in Smaller Quantities Disinfectant: Bodily Fluids and Diapering

When a product label instructs mixing 1/2 cup of bleach per gallon of water:

<u>Amount of Bleach</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>
1/2 cup	1 Gallon (128 oz)
2 Tbsp	1 Quart (32 oz)
1 Tbsp	1 Pint (16 oz)

When a product label instructs mixing 1/3 cup of bleach per gallon of water:

<u>Amount of Bleach</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>
1/3 cup	1 Gallon (128 oz)
4 tspn	1 Quart (32 oz)
2 tspn	1 Pint (16 oz)

When a product label instructs mixing 3/4 cup of bleach per gallon of water:

<u>Amount of Bleach</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>
3/4 cup	1 Gallon (128 oz)
2 Tbsp	1 Quart (32 oz)
1 Tbsp	1 Pint (16 oz)

When a product label instructs mixing 1 cup of bleach per gallon of water:

<u>Amount of Bleach</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>
1 cup	1 Gallon (128 oz)
4 Tbsp	1 Quart (32 oz)
2 Tbsp	1 Pint (16 oz)

When a product label instructs mixing 1 1/2 cup of bleach per gallon of water:

<u>Amount of Bleach</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>
1 1/2 cup	1 Gallon (128 oz)
6 Tbsp	1 Quart (32 oz)
3 Tbsp	1 Pint (16 oz)
